Non-member schools: £50 per participant, per session

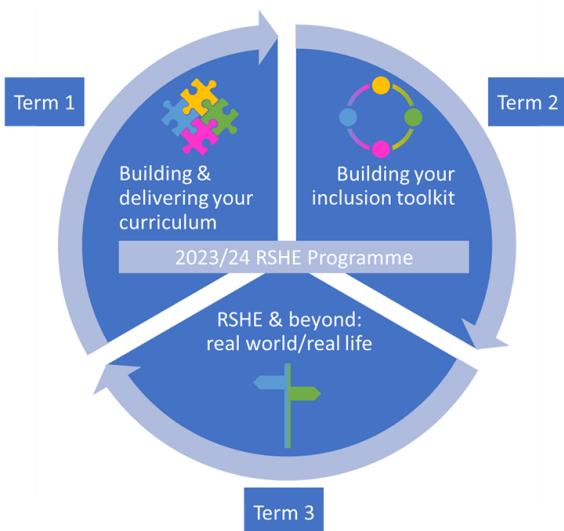
