


TSH Berkshire

- Designated as Teaching School Hub for Berkshire from September 2021




The Teaching School Hub programme

- 87 Teaching School Hubs were designated from September 2021 organised loosely on local authority boundaries.
- The focus for Teaching School Hubs is on teacher training and development, recognising teacher and leadership development as the most important form of school improvement.
- Hubs are expected to build strong partnerships with other schools to support teachers and leaders, at every stage of their career, in every phase and type of school in their hub area.

The Teaching School Hub remit



Teaching School Hubs are expected to undertake a range of activities including:

- Delivery of Initial Teacher Training (ITT)
- Delivery of the Early Career Framework (ECF)
- Providing Appropriate Body (AB) services for Early Career Teachers
- Delivery of the National Professional Qualifications (NPQs)
- Other Continuous Professional Development (CPD)
- Signposting to other DfE-funded sources of support and professional development e.g. curriculum hubs, research schools etc.
